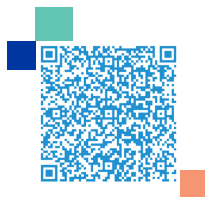

1. The honors curriculum requires pathway students to complete honors coursework in UK Core Inquiry.
2. Courses that fulfill the lower level honors seminar requirement include HON 151: Honors Humanities, HON 152: Honors STEM, HON 251: Honors Social Sciences, or HON 252: Honors Arts and Creativity.
3. All students are required to complete an honors capstone or thesis in their senior year.

Social Entrepreneurship Scholars are required to complete six hours of Honors Experiences. Honors Experiences include undergraduate research, education abroad, experiential learning, internships, co-ops, and service-learning opportunities.
