Applying for Upper Division	Cumulative and pre-major GPA of 2.8 is required for admission to Upper Division. You must be in-progress of completing your final pre-major courses to file the application. Apply at MyGatton.uky.edu
Dual Degree vs. Double Major	Dual degree requires 144 earned hours and students will receive two diplomas. Double major requires 120 earned hours with all major requirements completed and students will receive one diploma with all majors listed.
Electives	Electives can be any course offered for credit that is not one of the following: Military Science (lower division), music performance and composition, and one-credit hour KHP activity course.
