Gatton Glossary

AP and CLEP Exam Credit	AP credits and CLEP exams will be applied solely as credit without a letter grade.
Appeals	If either cumulative or pre-major GPA is lower than 2.8, submit an appeal for Upper Division. You may submit a total of two complete appeals to the Appeals Committee.
Applying for Upper Division	Cumulative and pre-major GPA of 2.8 is required for admission to Upper Division. You must be in-progress of completing your final pre-major courses to file the application. Apply at MyGatton.uky.edu
Dual Degree vs. Double Major	Dual degree requires 144 earned hours and students will receive two diplomas. Double major requires 120 earned hours with all major requirements completed and students will receive one diploma with all majors listed.
Electives	Electives can be any course offered for credit that is not one of the following: Military Science (lower division), music performance and composition, and one-credit hour KHP activity course.
Graduation	Apply for a degree by the deadline on myuky.edu. Register for commencement at Grad Salute or uky.edu/commencement.

Major GPA	Your major GPA is comprised of all courses taken in College Core, major content area, and GCCR.
MyGatton	Online resource for override requests, application for Upper Division, viewing contracts, non-UK course equivalency requests, and on-campus transfer applications. MyGatton.uky.edu
Overrides	If a course has reached capacity, visit MyGatton.uky.edu to submit an override request to the department following priority registration. Dept. will evaluate and communicate with student regarding availability.
Pass/fail	A total of four electives may be taken on a pass/fail basis if they are not being used to fulfill a requirement or taught through your major department.
Regular Grade Type	All English, pre-major, UK Core, college core, major courses, and bypass exams MUST be taken for a letter grade.
Repeat Options	Students are allotted three repeat options for their entire academic undergraduate career to replace the first attempt of a completed course with the second completed attempt of the same course.
Total Hours	Total hours must be ≥ 120 to qualify for graduation upon completion of required courses. Students pursuing a dual degree must have a minimum of 144 hours. See <i>Electives</i> for restrictions on applicable credit hours.
